WILD WILDEST WEST

Chuck Wagon Build and Race

If you're tired of riding the open range punchin' doggies along the digital Chisholm Trail, then saddle up for some real excitement by constructing and racing your own chuck wagon. All you need is your posse of ranch hands and a hankerin' for some high-noon fun. Groups divide into chuck wagon teams and compete for frontier points by successfully completing team challenges; building, decorating and racing their chuck wagons; performing their own campfire songs and dances at a hoedown; and demonstrating true "home on the range" spirit.

Cowboy Chili Cook-Off

There's nothin' like good bowls of chili to satisfy the hunger of hard working cowpokes. There's never a shortage of recipes among chuck wagon cooks, but only one can be called the "Cowboy Chili Cook-Off Champion." Groups divide into chuck wagon crews and must create original recipes using goods obtained through a scavenger hunt process. Judges may decide the contest, but the fun is in the making and eating of your team's tasty concoction.

Gold Rush Scavenger Hunt

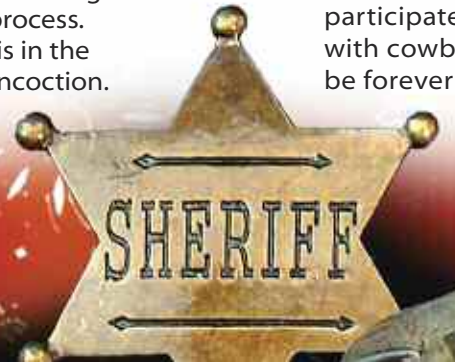
"Thar's gold in them thar hills," and your group of prospectors is pitted against other gold diggers in a fun race to see who finds the most nuggets. But like any gold rush adventure, there are twists and turns that make working your claim exciting. Groups divide into prospecting teams and find gold through a scavenger hunt challenge while fending off claim jumpers, bandits and unexpected calamities.

Shootout at the OK Corral

Re-live the most famous gunfight in the history of the Old West. In those lawless days when cattle rustlers, horse thieves, stagecoach robbers and card cheats kept one step ahead of the law, a band of law-and-order citizens decided to clean up their town. Groups divide into teams and determine which side of the law they represent through a series of exciting challenges followed by a memorable laser tag gunfight at the OK Corral.

Rodeo Games

Since the 1870s, rodeos have been the "Olympics" of cattle ranching skills and the peaceful way for wranglers to win bragging rights for their ranches. In researching the history of rodeos, we uncovered some rodeo games that test each other's skills at herding, roping, wrestling, tying and riding but, interestingly, without horses and cattle. Groups divide into ranches and participate in a fun rodeo skills contest along with cowboy-themed challenges that will be forever branded in your memory.





WILD WORLD OF SPORTS

Team Olympix

In the spirit of friendly competition, it's not all about winning, but collaborative effort, fair play, and personal team best. So light the torch and come together to build camaraderie and team unity in this "Olympix" of a different slant. To begin, groups divide into teams, create their country names, flags and cheers or national anthems. Then the games begin, but not the games you'll see on TV. These events are not judged on individual strength or speed but on agile and flexible teamwork. The better the teamwork, the higher the score.

Team Tournament

For sports-loving groups, GDX organizes fun tournaments that involve modified sports events and group games that are enjoyed by athletes and non-athletes alike. Some of the options are Beachball Volleyball, Monster Basketball, Blind Man Hockey, Ultimate Frisbee, Dodgebee, Dodgeball, Human Foosball, and Whiffle Ball. It's all about groups of average people winning by giving above average teamwork.

X-treme Team Challenge

GDX has its own "X Games" that will test your group both mentally and physically. Facing the most demanding elements of an upper ropes course coupled with other group and individual challenges that are certain to launch you out of your comfort zone, the X-treme thrill of achievement makes this program special. The goal is to push past perceived limits as a team and realize that there is much that your group can accomplish together.

All-Star Games

The "best of the best" play in all-star games, but in every team that competes, there are players with different roles. How those roles are assigned within a team can make the difference between winning and losing. In this exciting competition, teams must complete various sports skills to earn team points. Some of the activities include the football throw, basketball shoot, soccer kick, volleyball spike, baseball pitch, hockey shot, etc., but GDX levels the playing field with unusual but challenging twists. Teams have to decide which players compete in which events, but in these all-star games, the path to victory is through teamwork.

Championship Playoffs

It's the postseason, and your teams are all vying for the title of "Champion." To win it all, it takes more than ability. The difference between "try" and "triumph" is "umph" so unleash your unbridled enthusiasm and best efforts in a series of exciting games in playoff fashion. GDX can organize almost any sports competition you desire, but it does offer a number of specialty contests that can be fun for athletes and non-athletes alike. Some of these include Monster Basketball, Biggie Bowling, Human Foosball, Tarp Volleyball, Blind Hockey, Dodgebee or Dodgeball, and Weird Cup Soccer.

Rival Survival

How would your team survive on a wilderness island full of hidden dangers and unexpected obstacles? "Rival Survival" challenges your groups to pull together to overcome the elements, other fierce competitors, and your own limits to triumph as the tribe that survives. Each tribe creates its tribe name, chant and war dance, and while there are winners and losers in this friendly competition, nobody gets voted off the island.

Laser Tag Mission

Your mission should you decide to accept it is to eliminate the other combatants using extreme laser force and exceptional teamwork. Employing state-of-the-art, infrared weaponry that can be fired indoors or outdoors, individuals or commando teams have to overcome the chaos of combat and the thrilling nature of close-quarter gun fighting to fulfill their missions. A number of exciting scenarios are available, all of which can be conducted at GDX or at remote locations. One thing for certain, the experience is lively and team strategies are the key to victory.

Learning the Ropes

It's always exhilarating to view the world from high off the ground, particularly when you are navigating through a ropes course that challenges you in a multitude of ways. The goal is to overcome obstacles – physical or mental – that keep you from being successful on your journey. Using both lower and upper elements of a ropes course, GDX brings a fresh and fun approach to this highly experiential tool for individual and group learning. GDX operates one of the largest indoor courses in America and also has access to several outdoor courses in the area.

You'll Rock

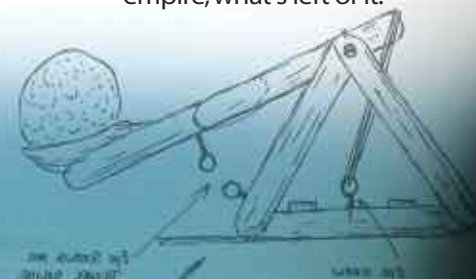

OFF TO THE RACES

Derby Days

Indianapolis, Daytona, Talladega, and now Group Dynamix... the right place to experience derby racing at the "formula" level. Your goal is to build and race your own derby car from the chassis and decals to racing jumpsuit and lap flag in this high-octane, turbo-charged team event.

Each race team works together to build team spirit by creating its pit crew name, cheer and victory dance. Teams then compete in various challenges to collect the parts to build their cars and determine "pole positions." Once the cars are built, it's "ladies and gentlemen, start your engines!" The excitement and fun is in high gear as the teams compete head to head in the "Derby Relay."

The Amazing Journey

Like the TV show of a similar name, this event is about your team overcoming obstacles, misdirection, challenges and penalties to keep ahead of your competition. However, GDX's version is mostly about having extraordinary fun without the pain and suffering. Teams compete in a timed scavenger hunt to find and solve clues that ultimately leads to the winning team arriving first on the final leg of the journey.

Craft a Raft

Your group is shipwrecked on a deserted island in the South Seas with only one way to get back home – build a seaworthy raft and paddle it. Of course, if your group is large enough, you must divide into crews and then some friendly naval warfare between pirates and privateers commences or the rafting version of the America's Cup begins. GDX provides the building materials but your team must earn them by successfully completing fun challenges. It's a wet and wild event with locations by any shore, natural or man-made, including pools.

Texas Relays

Most track and field events are far too grueling for GDX and most people in general, so it has developed its own fun relay events that both the tortoises and hares of your group can enjoy. Relays are team-based so each member has to contribute, and when the relays are totally whacky, the results are medal worthy whatever your team's place finish. Because it's the "Texas" relays, expect some of the contests to involve lassos, rattlesnakes, armadillos, cacti or cow pies.

Tour De Farce

Claiming victory in the Tour De France takes preparation by a great team. The same can be said for GDX's Tour De Farce although there are a few differences. First, bike teams are formed, named and their cheers and victory dances created. The teams then compete for "Road Rally Points" through a series of challenges to collect parts for their bikes. After building their bikes and decorating their victory flags and race suits, the world's second most prestigious bike race begins. Awards are given in various categories including the MVPP (Most Valuable Pedal Pusher), and to make the victories even sweeter, the bikes can be donated to the charity of your choice.

Operation Laser Tag

Using GDX's state-of-the-art laser tag system, it's all about whose left standing when the smoke clears. Choose from a variety of "shoot-em up" scenarios including the Shootout at the OK Corral, Hatfield-McCoy Feud, Cops and Gangsters, Capture the Flag, and Special Ops. Groups divide into teams that can play against each other or are assigned team missions to win a group victory. "Intense" is too mild a word to describe the excitement of these events.

Supersized Games

Everything looked big when you were a kid. So, take a trip back in time as your group gets treated to giant-like fun using oversized toys and extra-large challenges including monster ball games, giant trike and pedal cart races, biggie bowling, human foosball, jumbo jump rope, tarp volleyball, team skiing, adult-friendly inflatables and many more supersized activities. Groups divide into teams or play together to win big!

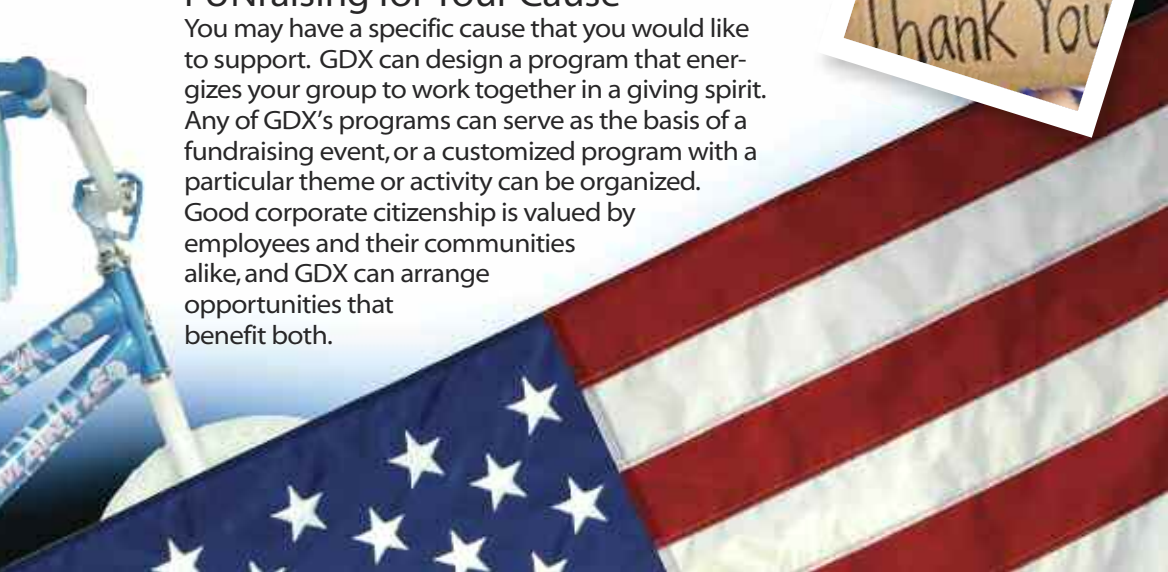
Thanking America's Heroes
